MackenzieHealth Limited (MHL) was established in 2003 by Malcolm Mackenzie, the former CEO of an insurance PLC, to help medical businesses in the UK health sector to improve their administration processes. MHL launched eCABS in mid 2005. Powered by THELMA, eCABS was designed as an Internet-based 'fire & forget' system for UK medical consultants (ie specialists) for the automated collection of their fees. The rollout of eCABS was hampered by the general lack of eCommerce awareness in UK health, and uncovered a much broader opportunity for achieving widespread Internet connectivity through working with the UK medical software vendors. Consequently, THELMA-UK is being rolled out, beginning with electronic consultant claims between medical software vendors and private health insurers. eCABS will then be rolled out off the back of THELMA-UK.
